

## PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFETY

	<ul> <li>Do not install, repair, open or remove the cover. It may expose you to dangerous voltages. Ask the dealer or the specialist to do this.</li> <li>Turning off the power supply will not prevent potential electric shock.</li> <li>The appliance shall be installed in accordance with national wiring regulation.</li> <li>Means for disconnection from the supply having a contact separation of at least 3 mm in all poles must be incorporated in the fixed wiring.</li> </ul>
<u>^</u> Marning	<ul> <li>Do not expose your body directly to cool air for a long time.</li> <li>Do not insert your finger or any article into the air inlet/outlet.</li> <li>When an abnormality (burning smell, etc.) occurs, stop the air conditioner and disconnect the power supply or turn off the breaker.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Do not wash the unit with water. It may cause an electric shock.</li> <li>Do not use this air conditioner for other purposes such as preserving food, breeding animal, etc.</li> <li>Do not step or put anything on the indoor/outdoor unit. It may cause an injury or damage the unit.</li> <li>Do not touch aluminium fin because it may cause an injury.</li> <li>Before cleaning the unit, turn off the main switch or the circuit breaker.</li> <li>When the unit won't be used for a long time, turn off the main switch or the circuit breaker.</li> <li>It is recommended that maintenance be performed by a specialist when the unit has been operated for a long time.</li> </ul>

#### PREPARATION BEFORE USE

#### Preparing Filters

- 1. Open the air inlet grille and remove the air filters.
- 2. Attach the filters. (see detail in the accessory sheet)
- Loading Batteries 1. Remove the cover. Insert 2 new
- batteries (AAA type) following the (+) and (-) positions.
- 2. Push RST : Reset the remote
- control.
- 3. Place the cover back.



# 3 AIRFLOW DIRECTION

1	Press 闭 FIX : Move the louver in the desired vertical direction.	
2	Press ⊽ SWING: Swing the air automatically and press again to stop.	
3	For horizontal direction, adjust manually.	

Note:

· Do not move the louver manually by others.

· The louver may move automatically positioning by operation mode.

# 5 AUTOMATIC OPERATION (AUTO CHANGEOVER)

- To automatically select cooling or fan only operation and control fan speed. 1. Press MODE : Select AUTO.
  - 2. Press V 🖁 🛦 : Set the desired temperature.
  - The manufacture setting temperature is  $24^{\circ}C$  and available range of set temperature is  $\pm 5^{\circ}C$ .

#### 6 COOLING / HEAT/AUTO FAN OPERATION

- 1. Press MODE: Select COOL, HEAT or AUTO FAN.
- Press ▼ ♣ ▲ : Set the desired temperature.
   COOL: Min 17°C, HEAT: Max 30°C, AUTO FAN : No temperature indication
- 3. Press 🚱 FAN : Select AUTO, QUIET, LOW a, MED â, HIGH â.

#### DRY OPERATION

For dehumidification, a moderate cooling performance is controlled automatically.

- 1. Press MODE : Select Dry.
- 2. Press V 🖁 🛦 : Set the desired temperature.

#### 8 ECONOMICAL OPERATION

- To automatically control room temperature, fan speed and operation mode 1. Press ECO in the AUTO and COOL operation: Start and stop the
  - operation.

2. Press MODE or FAN after stopping the operation.


- Note:
  - Under certain conditions, ECO mode may not provide adequate cooling due to energy saving features.

#### 9 TEMPORARY OPERATION

In case of the misplaced or discharged remote control

- Pressing the RESET button, the unit can start or stop without using the remote control.
- Operation mode is set on AUTOMATIC operation, preset temperature is 24°C and fan operation is automatic speed.

# **10 TIMER OPERATION**

#### Setting ON/OFF Timer

- Press ON or OFF.
   Press SET : Set the timer.
- 3. Press CLR : Cancel the timer.
- 4. Press () START/STOP : Stop the air conditioner timer.

#### Note

If you do not press the SET. ON or OFF button for 30 seconds, the timer setting is cancelled.

#### **AUTO RESTART OPERATION** 11

To automatically restart the conditioner after the power failure (Power of the unit must be on.)

#### Setting

1. Press and hold the RESET button on the indoor unit for 3 seconds to set the operation. (3 beep sound and OPERATION lamp blink 5 time/sec for 5 seconds)

- Do not operate ON timer and OFF timer.
- 2. Press and hold the RESET button on the indoor unit for 3 seconds to cancel the operation. (3 beep sound but OPERATION lamp does not blink)

## **12 QUIET OPERATION**

To operate at super low fan speed for quiet operation (except in DRY mode) Press SFAN : Select QUIET operation.

Note: Under certain conditions, QUIET operation may not provide adequate cooling or heating due to low sound features

## **13 MAINTENANCE**

Firstly, turn off the circuit breaker

#### Filter Reset (Some models only)

FILTER lamp lights on; the filter must be cleaned.

To turn off the lamp, push the RESET button on the indoor unit.

#### Indoor Unit and Remote Control

- Clean the indoor unit and the remote control with a wet cloth when needed.
- · No benzine, thinner, polishing powder or chemically-treated duster.

#### **OPERATION AND PERFORMANCE** 14

- 1. Three-minute protection feature: To prevent the unit from being activated for 3 minutes when suddenly restarted or switched to ON.
- 2. Preheating operation: Warm up the unit for 5 minutes before the heating operation starts.
- 3. Warm air control: When the room temperature reaches the set temperature, the fan speed is automatically reduced and the outdoor unit will stop
- Automatic defrosting: Fans will stop during defrost operation.
  Heating capacity: Heat is absorbed from outdoors and released into the room. When the outdoor temperature is too low, use another recommended heating apparatus in combination with the air conditioner.
- 6. Consideration for accumulated snow: Select the position for outdoor unit where it will not be subjected to snow drifts, accumulation of leaves or other seasonal debris.
- 7. Some minor cracking sound may occur when unit operating. This is normal because the cracking sound may be caused by expansion/ contraction of plastic.


The unit does not operate.	Cooling is abnormally low.	
<ul> <li>The power main switch is turned off.</li> <li>The circuit breaker is activated to cut off the power supply.</li> <li>Stoppage of electric current</li> <li>ON timer is set.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>The filters are blocked with dust.</li> <li>The temperature has been set improperly.</li> <li>The windows or doors are opened.</li> <li>The air inlet or outlet of the outdoor unit is blocked.</li> <li>The fan speed is too low.</li> <li>The operation mode is FAN or DBY</li> </ul>	

#### **REMOTE CONTROL A-B SELECTION** 16

To separate using of remote control for each indoor unit in case of 2 air conditioners are installed nearly.

#### Remote Control B Setup.

- 1. Press RESET button on the indoor unit to turn the air conditioner ON. 2. Point the remote control at the indoor unit.
- 3. Push and hold [CHK] button on the Remote Control by the tip of the
- pencii. "00" will be shown on the display.
  Press [MODE] during pushing [CHK]. "B" will show on the display and "00" will disappear and the air conditioner will turn OFF. The Remote Control B is memorized.
- Repeat above step to Note: 1. reset Remote Control to
  - be A. 2 Remote Control A has
  - not "A" display. 3. Default setting of
  - Remote Control from factory is A.
